MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY

(A) Posts under Government of Maharashtra:

Professor

- (A) (i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification in Economics and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college, and/or experience in research at the University/national level institutions/industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process.
- (iv) Minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), as per 'UGC (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) Regulations, 2010' and its amendments vide (2nd Amendment) Regulations 2013, (3rd Amendment) Regulations 2016, and (4th Amendment) Regulations 2016.

OR

- (B) An outstanding professional, with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

Associate Professor

- (i) For Associate Professor (Economics): Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in Economics.
For Associate Professor (Rural Sociology): Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in Sociology.
- (ii) For Associate Professor (Economics): Master's Degree in Economics with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)
For Associate Professor (Rural Sociology): Master's Degree in Sociology with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- (iii) Minimum eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- (iv) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology –mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- (v) Minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), as per 'UGC (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) Regulations, 2010' and its amendments vide (2nd Amendment) Regulations 2013, (3rd Amendment) Regulations 2016, and (4th Amendment) Regulations 2016.

Research Associate

- (i) Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in Economics.
- (ii) Desirable: Evidence of independent research work and good working knowledge of computer software packages and applications. Candidates should be willing to work in rural areas.

(B) Institutional Posts funded by Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics

Assistant Professor

- (i) For Assistant Professor (Economics): Good academic record, with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at Master's Degree in Economics from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

For Assistant Professor (Statistics): Good academic record, with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at Master's Degree in Statistics from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications specified under (i), the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by UGC or similar test accredited by UGC, such as SLET/SET, in the relevant subject.
- (iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i), and (ii) above, candidates who have been awarded Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the 'UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009', shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor.

NOTE:

- (1) Relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and master's degree level for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Differently Abled (physically and visually differently-abled)/Other Backward Classes (OBC non-creamy layer) categories, for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record. The eligibility of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible only on the basis of the qualifying marks without including any grace marks.
- (2) Relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to Ph. D. Degree holders who have obtained Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- (3) Ph.D. Degree shall be a mandatory qualification for appointment as Professor and Associate Professor. The period of time taken by the candidates to acquire M. Phil and/or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions.
- (4) Discretionary award of advance increments for candidates appointed as Associate Professor or Professor with higher merit, high number of research publications and experience at an appropriate level, if recommended by the Selection Committee, shall be subject to approval of the Board of Management and Government of Maharashtra.
- (5) The Institute reserves the right to fill or not to fill up the advertised posts.

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
