## SYLLABUS FOR MEDICAL OFFICER(ALLOPATHY)

- (I) The examination will comprise of:
- (a) **Written examination**: the candidates will take the examination in the following two papers each of two hours duration each carrying a maximum of 200 marks. The questions in both the papers will be so designed as to give the following weightage to different subjects.

## Paper-I(CODE NO): 200 Marks (i) General Medicine including Cardiology, Neurology, Dermatology and Psychiatry. 60%(120 marks) (ii) Surgery including E.N.T. Opthalmology Traumatology and Orthopaedics. 40%(80 marks) Paper-II(Code no.2): 200 marks (ii) Paediatrics 20%(40 marks) (iii) Gynecology and Obsterics 40%(80 marks) (iii) Preventive, Social and Community medicine 40%(80 marks) (b) Viva-voce: 50 marks (i) Personality test and General aptitude 10%(10 marks)

(II) The examination in both the papers will be completely of objective (multiple choice answer) type. The question papers(test booklets) will be set in English only.

- (III) Candidates must write the papers in their own hand. In no circumstances will they be allowed the help of scribe to write answers for them.
- (IV) Candidates are not permitted to use calculators for answering objective type paper(test booklets). They should not, therefore, bring the same inside the examination hall.
- (V) Selection on the basis of maximum marks in written and viva-voce.
- (VI) No negative marking/ minimum qualifying marks.

(ii) General medical subjects for MO(Allopathy)
