Applications in prescribed form are invited from intending candidates of Bargarh District for filling up the following categories of posts in the 3nos of Upgraded High Schools and other existing High Schools under ST & SC Development Department of Bargarh District on Contractual Basis. In case of non-availability of suitable candidates from Bargarh District, applications of the candidates from other Districts will be considered. But the posts of "Junior Clerk" and "Peon" are meant for the candidates belonging to Bargarh District only.

NB:- The vacancy position has been derived including backlog vacancies by scrupulously following ORV Act 1975 and rules made there under.

General eligibility:-

- (a) He/She must be a citizen of India.
- (b) He/She must bear a good character and shall furnish along with the application a certificate of good character from the Head of the Institutions in which he/she last studied.
- (c) (i) He/She must have passed the High School Certificate or an equivalent or any Higher Examination with Odia as a language subject or
(ii) He/She must have Odia as a medium, of examination in non-language subject at the High School Certificate or equivalent examination, which He/She have passed.
- (d) Candidates having Bachelor Degree in Arts/ Commerce/ Science with Bachelor Degree in Education from any University of the State or its equivalency are eligible. Regarding Universities/

Institutions of outside State, the candidates shall only be eligible for engagement after verification of genuineness of their educational/ training qualification from concerned University/ Institution from which they have obtained the Degree.

- (e) Such outside University/ Institution pass out candidates shall have to produce the authenticated proof of equivalency and NCTE recognition in support of their qualification at the time of verification failing which their case will not be entertained.
- (f) He/She must not have more than one spouse living.

1. **Age:-**

For the post of Teachers & Junior Clerk

He/She must be below 32Yrs and above 21Yrs. Of age as on 01.01.2018 provided that maximum age limit shall be relaxed by 5Years in case of candidates belong to the ST, SC, SEBC & Woman candidates. Age shall be relaxed for Ex-Service man as per Odisha Ex-Service Man Rule,1989. In case of PH candidate the upper age shall be relaxed by 10 years.

For the Post of Peon

He/She must be below 32 Yrs and above 18 Yrs of age as on 01.01.2018 provided that maximum age limit shall be relaxed by 5 Years in case of candidates belong to the ST,SC,SEBC & Woman candidates. Age shall be relaxed for Ex-Service man as per Odisha Ex-Service Man Rule 1989. In case of PH candidate the upper age shall be relaxed by 10 years.

2. **Educational Qualification**

- (a) BA.BED. Teacher – He/She must have obtained Bachelor Degree in Arts/ Commerce (with two school subjects) from a recognized university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/ SEBC candidates) along with a degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.
- (b) BSc.BEd. Teacher - He/She must have obtained Bachelor Degree in Science (PCM/CBZ) (with two school subjects) from a recognized university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/ SEBC candidates) along with a degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.
- (c) Sanskrit Teacher – Bachelor Degree with Sanskrit as one of the optional/ Hons subject from a recognized University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/ SEBC candidates) with Sikhya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognized University / Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

OR

Sanskrit (Sanskrit) with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) from recognized University and Sikhya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by

NCTE) from a recognized University/ Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

OR

Acharya (Except Jyotishacharya and Ayurvedacharya) or Shityacharya with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized University.

OR

Bachelor's Degree with Sanskrit as one of the optional/ Hons. subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) and MA in Sanskrit with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized University.

In case trained candidates are not available, untrained candidates shall be engaged.
(The untrained candidates shall have to undergo required training within the time line as prescribed by Govt.)

- (d) **Hindi Teacher** – Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University with Hindi as one of the elective subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) or with Rastrabhasa Ratna from Rastrabhasa Prachar Samiti, Wardha or with Sastri from Odisha Rastrabhasa Parisada, Puri or with Snataka (Acquired by June 2005, the date up to which the temporary recognition has been granted) from Hindi Sikshya Samiti, Odisha, Cuttack or an equivalent Degree from a recognized institution with at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) and Hindi Sikshyan Parangat from Kendriya Hindi Sansthan, Agra/ B.H.Ed. (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University/ BEd. in Hindi (a course prescribed by NCTE) from Dakhin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha, Madras, a institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

OR

Bachelor's Degree with Hindi as one of the optional/ Hons subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) and MA in Hindi with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized University.

In case trained candidates are not available, untrained candidates shall be engaged.
(The untrained candidates shall have to undergo required training within the time line as prescribed by Govt.)

- (e) **PET** – Matric or its equivalent examination with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) and CPED from recognized Board/ University.

(For the post of BA BEd. / BSc.BEd./ Sanskrit Teacher/ Hindi Teacher/ PET the candidates must have to pass OSSTET conducted by BSE, Odisha within the prescribed timeline)

- (f) **Junior Clerk** – He/She must have passed Graduation or equivalent examination from recognized University as per GA Deptt Resolution No.27367/Gen./Dtd.29.11.2017 with basic computer knowledge.
- (g) **Peon** – He/She must have passed ME Examination.

The B.Ed./B.H.Ed./Sikshya Sashtri candidates should have registered their names either in the Employment Bureau located at Vanivihar, Bhubaneswar/ Jyoti Vihar, Sambalpur/ Bhanja Vihar, Berhampur/ OUAT, Bhubaneswar or in the State Employment Exchange, Bhubaneswar or in any District Employment Exchange. The candidates for PET/ Classical/Hindi teachers/ Junior Clerk/ Peon should have registered their names in the Employment Exchange located in the concerned Revenue District which he/she belongs to /State Employment Exchange. SC/ST and PH candidates should have registered their name in the Special Employment Exchange for SC/ST & PH at Bhubaneswar or in any Employment Exchange located in the concerned Revenue District which he/she belongs to.

3. Reservation:-

The Odisha Reservation of Vacancies (In post and services for ST & SC) Act.1975 and the Odisha Reservation of Posts & Services for Socially & Educationally Backward Classes Act,2008 and the rules made there under and such other principles of the post based reservation as prescribed by the State Government on the land mark judgment of Hon'ble High Court/ Supreme Court, from time to time, shall be followed.

One third of the notified vacancies will be reserved for Women Candidates of respective categories. Similarly 4% will be reserved for Physically Handicapped as per the provision of Section-33 of the "Person with disabilities" (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation Act), 1% for eminent sports personnel and 3% for Ex-serviceman.

Instructions contained in SSEPD Deptt. Resolution No.7140/Dtd.05.09.2017 shall be adhered to for (PwDs) candidates.

The PH candidates shall be referred to the Appellate Medical Board constituted by W&CD Department vide Notification No.16430/WCD/Dtd.06.09.2011 for re-examination. Engagement order shall be issued if such candidates found genuine by the Board.

4. Emoluments & Service condition:-

The emoluments and service conditions shall be guided as per the provisions of G.A. Deptt. Notification No.32010/Dtd.12.11.2013 & No.19569/Gen./Dtd.12.09.2017 & No.19574/Gen./Dtd.12.09.2017.

5. Remuneration :-

The contractual Teaching & Non-teaching staff will be paid following consolidated remuneration as per Govt. in Finance Deptt. Letter No.28090/F/ Dtd.22.09.2017.

6. Mode of application:-

Application complete in all respect along with the relevant documents should be sent in a closed cover addressed to the District Welfare Officer, Bargarh, Pin-768028 by Regd. Post/ Speed Post only so as to reach him on or before 10/08/2018. The applications received after due date/ Courier Service/ By hand shall not be considered.

7. Selection Procedure:-

The selection will be made by the District Selection Committee headed by the Collector, Bargarh, Inspector of Schools (SSD) Sambalpur, District Inspector of Schools (SSD) Bargarh and District Welfare Officer, Bargarh (Member Convener) are the members of the Committee (as per Govt. in ST&SC Development Deptt. Notification No.33475/TW/Dtd.13.12.1993).

The candidates for the post of Junior Clerk shall be engaged after qualifying the Computer Proficiency Test.

Selection shall be made only on merit i.e. on the basis of percentage of marks.

After verification, Merit List (150%) shall be prepared for each category of candidates on the basis of the percentage of marks secured in HSC Examination (without extra optional if any), BA/B.Com(without Ancillary & Foundation course if any) & B.Ed Examination in case of TG (Arts & Science Teacher) and in case of Sanskrit, Hindi, PET, & Junior Clerk (without extra optional/ Ancillary & Foundation course if any), the percentage of marks secured by a candidate in each qualifying examination.

In case of Peon Merit List (150%) shall be prepared on the basis of percentage of marks secured in ME/7th Class pass Examination.

(i) In case of two or more candidates secured the same marks the candidate older in age will be placed above in the rank.

(ii) If there is further tie, the higher percentage of marks secured in training qualification will be taken in to account.

(iii) Higher education will not be given any weightage during preparation of merit list in all categories.

(iv) The candidates selected for the post of Peon shall be engaged after counter verification of 7th Class pass Certificate by the concerned Block Education Officer/ District Education Officer, Bargarh.

10. No TA, DA will be allowed at the time of verification of original certificates. The incomplete applications and applications received after due date will be summarily rejected.
