## **GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS**

- **1.** The above positions are purely temporary and co-terminus with the scheme. Canvassing in any form will render the candidate disqualified for the position.
- **2.** Details of vacancy, eligibility, age, scheme of selection procedure etc. can be downloaded from the district website (<u>www.kalahandi.nic.in</u>).
- **3.** Candidates are required to apply in prescribed format available in the website <u>www.kalahandi.nic.in</u> and to submit along with a set of self attested copies of all certificates in support of age, qualification, experience, residence etc. Candidates are also required to submit two recent passport size colour photograph, an ID proof (Voter ID/ PAN/ Driving Licence /Passport/ Aadhar card) and recent (issued within 6 months) Caste & Residence certificate issued by the competent authority. No documents / certificate will be accepted at later stage of recruitment, if failed to submit with the application. Incomplete application in any form will be rejected.
- **4.** Candidates, who are already working in Health Department either on regular or on contractual basis, have to submit **No Objection Certificate** from the appointing authority.
- 5. <u>Marital Status</u>: A candidate if married must not have more than one spouse living, provided that the Government may, if satisfied that there are other specific grounds for allowing such marriage exempt any person from the operation of these rules.
- **6.** A candidate must be of good mental and physical health and free from any physical defects likely to make her incapable of discharging her normal duties in the service. A Candidate, who after such medical examination as the government may prescribe is not found to be satisfy the requirement shall not be appointed to the service.
- **7.** For all the above posts the candidates must:
  - a) Be able to read, write and speak Odia;
  - b) Have passed middle school examination with Odia as language subject; or
  - c) Have passed matriculation or equivalent examination with Odia as medium of examination in non-language subject; or
  - d) Have passed in Odia as language subject in the final examination of class VII from a school or educational institution recognized by the Government of Odisha or the Central Government; or
  - e) Have passed a test in Odia in Middle English School standard conducted by School & Mass Education Department.

## **ELIGIBILITY & SELECTION GUIDELINE**

## Name of the Position: AYUSH Doctor ( Ayurvedic/Homeopathic)

**Eligibility** - Must have passed Bachelor Degree in Ayurvedic Medicine & Surgery (BAMS) / Bachelor Degree in Homeopathic Medicine & surgery (BHMS) from recognized university. The candidate must have completed compulsory internship, if any. Candidates having PG degree in BAMS/BHMS will be given additional weightage. Must have registered in the Odisha state council/Board of Ayurvedic/ Homeopathic Medicine and should have valid registration certificate. No provisional registration is acceptable.

Age: 21 yrs – 37 yrs as on 01.06.2018

Monthly Remuneration: Rs.20,880/- + Other Allowances as admissible

**Mode of selection**: Ayurvedic and Homeopathic shall be recruited in the proportion of 9:8. Separate merit list will be prepared separately for Ayurvedic and Homeopathic Doctor.

Selection shall be made strictly based on the basis of merit to be assessed in the following manner. Weightage shall be calculated on the basis of marks BHMS/BAMS examination and the career weightage taken together in the following manner.

- For BHMS/BAMS the marks should be calculated basing on the marks secured and full marks thereof.

## Name of Position: STAFF NURSE

However, age relaxation & reservation policy of state Govt. is to be followed in toto, for candidates fulfilling criteria prescribed in the said policy (except for ASHA).

**Minimum Educational Qualification:** The Candidate must have passed in General Nursing & Midwife / B.Sc. Nursing from any 3 Govt. Nursing schools of 3 Medical College/ School of Nursing MCL Talcher/ IGH Rourkela or other recognized private institutions duly approved by NIC and must have registered in the Odisha Nursing Council.

**Registration:** The candidate must have registered her/his name in the Nursing Council in the State and have valid registration certificate as on the date of advertisement.

## Name of Position: ANM

**Eligibility Criteria:** In order to be eligible for direct recruitment to the post of ANM, a candidate shall have to satisfy the following conditions, namely-

**Age limit-** S/he must have attained the age of 21 years and must not be above the age of 32 years as on **01.06.2018** except ASHAs those who have completed 1 year in the health system in the state and below the age of 45 years. S/he shall be allowed to take part in the recruitment process if having the minimum qualification as required for HW (F). However, age relaxation & reservation policy of State Govt. is to be followed in Toto, for candidates fulfilling criteria prescribed in the said policy (except for ASHA).

**Minimum Educational Qualification**- The candidates must have passed the HSC examination & shall have completed ANM course from institutions recognized by Govt. and approved by INC and must have registered in the Odisha nursing council.

**Registration** - The candidates must have registered her/his name in the Odisha Nursing Council in the state and have possessed valid registration certificates as on the date of advertisement.

**District Preference** - Candidates having permanent Residence of Kalahandi District will be given preference. In case of non availability of eligible candidates from the district, candidates from other districts will be considered.
