Important Instructions for Teaching Post

1. For all the posts, the eligibility criteria shall be in accordance with the latest UGC Regulations. Conversion formula should be enclosed with application form wherever grading is followed.
2. Candidates in service should submit application through proper channel or enclose "NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE" from their current employer. Application received after stipulated date or incomplete application shall summarily be rejected; no further correspondence will be made in this regard.
3. Mere submission of application/satisfying the eligibility criteria does not entail the candidate to be called for interview. University reserves the right to shortlist the applications and call for interview. The University also reserves the right to reject the candidature of the candidate at any stage of recruitment/selection process if anything found false, tampered, fabricated or suppression of any information while registering the application and submitting the certificates/testimonials.
4. If there is any change in the address after submission of application, the candidates should in his/her own interest arrange with the post office concerned for redirection of the communication from old to new address.
5. Separate application is required to be submitted for each Post.
6. Against specific reserved quota, only candidates of that particular quota will be considered. A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master's level for the SC/ST/ /Other Backward Classes (Non-creamy layer)EWS/PWD categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records: Please note-(i) Caste certificates from competent authority for SC & ST candidates in the prescribed format have to be produced. PWD candidates claiming the benefits of reservations should submit a copy of Medical Certification as specified in the Disabilities Act of 1995 in support of their disability. (ii) If the candidates wish to be considered against a specific community quota and tick the community column accordingly, their application will be rejected unless proof of community in the prescribed format is enclosed: and (iii) any subsequent representation for change or community status will not be entertained under any circumstances.
7. Reservation is available for Persons with Disabilities under section 33 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Right & full Participation), Act, 1995. As reservation for PWD candidates is on horizontal basis, the selection candidates will be placed in the appropriate category (viz. SC/ST/OBC/PWD/EWS/UR).
8. Applicants for the reserved post of OBC are required to submit a certificate regarding his/her "OBC Status and belongingness to NO CREAMY LAYER" from the appropriate competent authority.



9. EWS certificate as per notification of Government of India is to be attached for candidates applying under EWS category.
10. The application form should be maintained neat and clean and signed by the candidate in his own handwriting only.
11. Candidate should clearly mention the correspondence address with pine code carefully as applicable otherwise application shall be rejected.
12. Application once submitted will not be allowed to be withdrawn and fees once paid will not be refunded on any account nor can it be held in serve for any other purpose.
13. The University reserves the right to postpone/cancel this recruitment exercise for any/all the posts.
14. No TA/DA shall be admissible for attending the interview.
15. Canvassing in favour of candidature both direct and indirect is strictly prohibited. Violation of the code of conduct will be treated as misconduct and will be brought to the notice of Selection Committee. The University reserve the right to cancel candidature of such candidates at any point of time if found in canvassing in any form.
16. Those candidates who have applied against earlier Advt. No. 08/2014-2015 may apply afresh through online / update their application form and need not pay the application fee. ,
